ITEMS PERTAINING TO AVIATION SAFETY AND AERODROME SECURITY

1. The Airport Manager issued a number of Runway Surface Condition reports, through NavCanada.

ITEMS PERTAINING TO AERODROME MAINTENANCE AND EQUIPMENT

- 1. January 6, a buildup of ice, on the roof of City Hangar # 2 (leased by Heritage Kitchens) shifted causing damage to the roof vents.
- 2. January 10, workers from Richard Steele Construction repaired the damaged roof vents on Hangar # 2.
- 3. January 15, the Airport Manager conducted a scheduled inspection of the City's NonDirectional Beacon facility. Routine function tests indicated that all of the transmitter's systems were operating normally.

GENERAL REMARKS

1. January 18, members of the Canadian Forces carried out a training exercise on the Airport property. The event was well covered by the local media which, in turn, meant for good publicity for the Airport.
