The Airport Commission is in full agreement with the Royal Canadian Air Cadets replacing the airport storage shed that is only utilized by the cadets. As with the current one, airport staff would have the key to access it. As long is the shed is less than 9' x 9' a building permit is not required. The cadets will be responsible for everything associated with the project including dismantling the current shed and disposal costs.

6. Airport Operations

B. Huskinson stated that there is a net expense to operating the airport but the airport is a service just like snow plowing the streets, providing a transit system, operating the arenas, etc. are services provided to the community. Operating the airport is a required basic service if you want to exist as a relevant community. B. Huskinson stated that this facility is a fixed winged airport and provided the attached updated listing of the 27 aircraft housed at this location. The Airport Commission's mandate is to promote the airport not cut it back to a helipad operation. If we are considering doing that then all 27 aircraft owners at the airport should be invited to a meeting to speak about it. Everyone should also remember that some \$300,000 dollars of in-kind or cash donations was provided to the City by industry for the runway expansion of 2005.

7. Action Item Update

As approved by the Commission on December 1, 2011 the sale price of Jet A1 fuel was increased to \$1.96 + HST per litre.

A report was presented to the December 7, 2011 Finance and Operations Committee Meeting

recommending that Council accept the proposal from Brock Air Services Limited in the amount of One Hundred and Four Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Eight Dollars (\$104,868.00) excluding HST with an annual CPI adjustment for Contract 2011-23 for the Operation and Management of the Brockville 1000 Islands Regional Tackaberry Airport for a three (3) year period commencing January 1, 2012. The report was passed at committee level and it goes to Council tonight for ratification.

A report was presented to the December 7, 2011 Finance and Operations Committee Meeting indicating that the Commission supports the sale of Andy Bouchard hangar to the new purchaser. The report was passed at committee level and it goes to Council tonight for ratification. Valerie Harvey will send correspondence to Andy Bouchard regarding the outcome of Council meeting.

8. New Business

Boards and Commissions are scheduled to do their 2012 budget presentations the evening of Tuesday, January 3, 2012. The Chair Brian Williams indicated that he will be away on holidays and not available for the meeting. Valerie Harvey was to check with Treasury to see if a airport representative was required in light of the fact that our budget is coming in at -6.46% over last year's budget.

The Chair Brian Williams indicated that he will also be away for the January meeting and requested that at the time of the meeting a member be nominated to chair the meeting that evening.

Valerie Harvey was requested to send a copy of the Airport Commission's term of reference to all members.

The Airport Commission Chairman reminded all members that In Camera sessions are confidential and any information from the In Camera session cannot be discussed with anyone except Airport Commission Members. Discussing information with other individuals violates policy and procedures.
