- 1. September 3, Kids Kreations Brockville very kindly agreed to donate a new, wooden storage shed to the Airport. The shed will be used by the Royal Canadian Air Cadets to safely secure their equipment in while providing glider familiarization flights at the Airport.
- 2. September 12, the Airport Manager conducted a scheduled inspection of the NonDirectional Beacon facility. Routine function tests indicated that all of the transmitter's systems were operating normally. Brush was cut and removed from the area around the building.
- 3. September 18, the City's insurance provider visited the Airport and visually inspected the City's buildings.
- 4. September 18, Steve Kotack, an Enforcement Inspector with Industry Canada/Measurements Canada inspected the City's aviation fuel pumping system.
- 5. September 19, Brockville Fire Protection performed an annual inspection of the Airport's fire extinguishers.

GENERAL REMARKS

1. September 24, an aerial photography provider, hired by the City's Economic Development office, launched an unmanned aerial vehicle in order to document pictures of the Airport.

I was wondering if you could direct me to someone who could answer some questions regarding airplane traffic at the Brockville Municipal Airport. Specifically, there has been a huge increase in planes taking off in the area since this summer and they all go directly over the Tincap Subdivision. Of particular concern is that between 10:30 and 11:30 p.m. no matter when I go to bed there is an airplane every 10-15mins almost as if they're practicing take-off and landing every night of the week. I can't imagine there is that much traffic that passes through the airport at that time of the night. I understand emergency requirements, and even the weekend Air Cadets / Gliders all day long, but it's really an inconvenience at night. It may be that the planes used to take off in a different direction as well. Short of contacting Transport Canada I don't know where to voice this concern.


I'd really appreciate some direction to follow-up on this concern.
